Despite the continued challenges of COVID, in 2021 we created new spaces for our tenants and their clients, welcomed new partners into our center and invested resources in upgrades to the "home" where the local nonprofit sector can flourish.

52 ORGANIZATIONS attended professional development sessions offered by our center

30 ORGANIZATIONS received technical support in their operations and/or development representing 90 free consultation hours

Over the year we expanded new meeting and co-working spaces to manage social distancing, invested in additional equipment and systems shared by 14 organizations, improved enhanced wayfinding elements throughout our building, maintained 80% occupancy and welcomed 4 new partners into our center. We accomplished this while still maintaining our nonprofit tenants' overhead rental costs at 50% of local commercial rates.


Placemaking is about the physicality and the emotions of space. We know our community is special. In 2021, our staff and board of directors created the necessary processes to ensure that our doors stayed open for our tenants and for the community we all serve. We know that shared resources lead to collective impact. The people who walk in our door seeking services are not always living their best lives but the programs who "live" in our space support a resilient community...even during a pandemic. We also worry about sustainability. Maintaining an historic building in the heart of our vibrant and growing city isn't without its challenges to the bottom line. Which is why our board of directors commits a portion of our annual revenue

towards funding building and operational reserves. In 2021, we placed an additional \$22,034 into reserves and completed \$100,000+ in major conditional improvements to the building and upgraded systems. Over the course of the year, our building stayed at least 80-90% occupied.

Our financial model is largely based on earned revenue from tenant occupancy and in 2021, it represented 84% of our total revenue. Additional support comes from a loyal group of donors, corporate sponsors and grants and other gifts. For our nonprofit tenants, the money they save on rent is reinvested into their direct service programming.
